Our story starts at Primark where Bertie, as his mother called him, was born in 1866 in rooms above a shop on the site. What follows is a tale, told in his own words, of two broken legs, infidelity and sexual awakenings, fights and battles, real and imagined, all set against the background of Victorian Bromley's phenomenal growth in the late 1800's. On our walk we will see the places and buildings that Bertie knew, many of which are still there today – including several in the Arts and Crafts style fashionable at the time.
